If you opt to deliver merchandise to the buyers during Farm Fest hours, you are subject to the following regulations:

- Items such as arts and crafts, clothing, small household items, and direct marketing products may be sold by approval from the Farm Fest coordinators. This includes items that are new and are small enough to be placed in a sack and conveniently carried by the buyer.
- A copy of your state tax number must appear on your contract.
- Along with the contract, Exhibitor must submit a photo or brochure for approval showing all merchandise to be sold at his or her booth. Only new items will be approved for retail sales.
- Each Exhibitor is responsible for collecting the appropriate taxes on every item sold.
- Exhibitor should have enough salable items on hand to keep their exhibit looking complete.

RULES AND REGULATIONS BINDING TO EXHIBITOR AND TO CABOOL AREA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

- All exhibits must be in place by 9:00 a.m. on Friday, May 8, 2009.
- All exhibits must remain in place until 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 9, 2009.
- Exhibitors supply their own display tables, chairs, drop cords, and connections to our outlets. Those exhibiting cattle supply their own cattle panels, bedding, feed, etc.
- Cabool Area Chamber of Commerce shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to the property of an Exhibitor or their employees before, during, or after the Farm Festival.
- Exhibitors must park their vehicles in the special area designated for them unless a vehicle is part of an exhibit and is parked in the booth.
- Booths are assigned on a first come basis and Farm Festival reserves the right to assign space.
- There shall be no cancellation of a booth unless Farm Festival finds a replacement for that spot.
- Cabool Area Chamber of Commerce has the final right to settle any dispute, cancel any contract, and enforce any regulations.
- There shall be no gambling or sales of intoxicating spirits. Exhibitors agree to abide by city, county, and state laws.
